
choose to provide that information to us. We do not give, share, sell, or transfer any personal information to a third party.

Cancellation & Fee Refund Policy

Fees once paid are refundable as per Institute policies but are not transferable.

- All refund requests must be submitted by the student/parents in writing addressed to the Director/Principal, in person, by regular mail, or by email. The Director/Principal shall acknowledge the receipt of the same. Telephone messages are NOT acceptable.
- All dues need to be paid in order for the formalities of withdrawal to be completed.
- The fee refund is solely based on the balance amount in the student's account after all applicable dues owed to the institute are deducted. Discounts or concessions provided may be void and may not apply upon withdrawal.
- The excess payment received through technical or other reasons will be refunded only after due verification and/or within 30 days after receipt of written complaint by the parent/student.
- The mode of refund will be electronic/ physical and will be refunded in the account from where the transaction was made.
